The Guth family

Jossel (sic)-Shlomo (Schlaum) – son of Elias Guth (Guth – in German) was born in ca 1848.

His father: Elias (Elies) – son of Schmuel Guth was born in ca 1808. His family belonged to the Jewish community in Friedrichstadt at least since 1834. Jossel's mother: Chaye (maiden name is not stated), born in ca 1814.

On August 21 of 1874 in Bausk Jossel Guth married Zisle (Sisle)-Rochel – daughter of Abram Feitelman from Bausk.

Zisle-Rochel was born in ca 1953-1854, obviously in Bausk. The birth records of the Jewish community in Bausk for 1854 do not contain information on her birth.

Her father: Abram – son of Chaim Feitelman, born in ca 1821. His father was Chaim – son of Judel Feitelman, born in ca 1791 (in census of 1834 his surname was written down as Feitel, in some documents surname was wrongly written down as Feitelsohn). His wife Lea (Leie) was born in ca 1798, she died as a widow on December 11 of 1856 in Bausk. The family of Chaim Feitelman was transferred from the membership of Jewish community in Zohden pagast (small rural district) of Bausk district to the membership of Jewish community in Bausk since 1834.

Abram Feitelman died on October 31 of 1887 in Bausk.

Zisle-Rochel's mother: Sorre-Rivka (Rebecca) (maiden name is not stated), born in ca 1825. She died on December 7 of 1890 in Bausk.

Jossel Guth and his wife Zisle-Rochel had at least seven children:

- daughter Lea-Base, born in ca 1874, died on September 26 of 1877 in Bausk, aged 2
 ½. The birth records of the Jewish community in Bausk for 1874-1875 do not contain information on her birth.
- son Hirsch-Chaim, born on December 2 of 1876 in Bausk,
- son **Elias** (**Elies**), born on December 24 of 1878 in Bausk,
- daughter Chaya, born on March 20 of 1882 in Bausk,
- daughter Ete-Dvaure, born on July 25 of 1884 in Bausk,
- daughter Dobre, born on April 13 of 1889 in Bausk,
- son Esriel (Ezriel), born on May 21 of 1893 in Bausk.

All dates are stated according to the Julian calendar.

Zisle-Rochel Guth, her daughter Chaya and sister Lea-Mina Feitelman died on June 25 of 1894 in Bausk, cause of death – cholera.

The Passport Issuance Book of Bausk prefecture for 1920-1927 and the records of the archives fond "State Statistics Board" – census for 1935 contain the following information:

- Izrael (sic) son of Jossel Guth,
- his wife Sonia (sic) Guth, daughter of Shloma Guth, born on July 19 of 1895 in Friedrichstadt,
- their children:
- son Iser-Mendel, born on January 4 of 1919 in Bausk,

- daughter Rocha, born on August 2 of 1921 in Bausk,
- daughter Male, born on April 15 of 1923 in Bausk,
- daughter Sore, born on March 20 of 1925 in Bausk,
- daughter Chaya, born on November 6 of 1931 in Bausk,
- son Jossel, born on November 6 of 1931 in Bausk.

According to the census for 1935 they lived in Bausk at Vienibas Street 19, apt.3.
